Initial Report After Hurricane Irma

At this point, it appears the park has sustained **very little damage** after Hurricane Irma passed through the middle of the state on its northward projectory on Monday, September 11.

Although the entire Wauchula area was affected by power outages for several days, power to the park was partially restored Wednesday. The Peace River Electrical Cooperative continues to work 16-hour shifts to make sure everyone gets their lights back on. The sewer and water systems are working.

Everyone is safe. Danny Lindstrom and Dick Pearce stayed in the area to assess and manage any impact the hurricane might have had on the park, and we owe them a huge debt of gratitude.

Gas stations are slowly opening as electricity and gasoline become available. Diesel fuel, however, is still not readily available.

We are blessed to have dodged a bullet. Arcadia, just 22 miles south of the park, was one of the hardest hit areas.

The park is open for business as usual this fall and winter.
